As an elected official and public servant, the newly re-elected judge feels it is her duty to promote greater understanding of the courts and the legal system by speaking at schools and other community forums.

On October 9, 2014 at 7:00 p.m., Judge Baker will once again participate in the Melbourne Police Community Relations Council Annual Community Forum at the Grant Street Community Center in Melbourne.

On October 10th, at 2 p.m., Judge Baker will visit Merritt Island High School as part of her continued involvement with the *Justice Teaching* program, which matches a judge or attorney to middle schools and high schools in Brevard County. Judge Baker has been a Justice Teaching volunteer at Merritt Island High School for the past four years, where she engages students in animated discussions on the U.S. Constitution and the role it plays in our democracy.

Judge Baker will participate in a judicial forum hosted by the National Business Institute on **November 14, 2014 in Orlando** by serving on a panel discussion entitled, "As Judges See It: Top Mistakes Attorneys Make in Civil Litigation."

Judge Baker also continues to host field trips for various schools and civic organizations at the Harry T. and Harriette V. Moore Justice Center in Viera.
