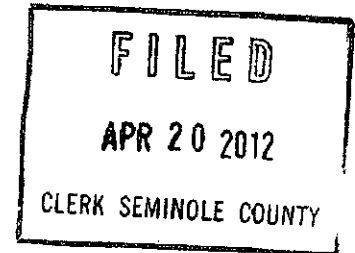

**ORDER ON MATTERS ADDRESSED AT STATUS CONFERENCE**

**THIS COURT** held a status conference in chambers on April 19, 2012. Brief matters were discussed and resolved as follows:

1. At the Defendant's request, he is permitted to dress in civilian clothing at the Bond Hearing presently set for April 20, 2012. Defendant's counsel shall coordinate with the Seminole County Sheriff's Office the logistics of providing the clothing to the Defendant. However, the Defendant shall be restrained in accordance with the policies of the Seminole County Sheriff's Office.
2. In order to protect his witnesses' privacy and ensure their safety, the Defendant is authorized to make arrangements for his witnesses to appear telephonically before a notary public authorized to administer oaths so long as they are advised of and directed to comply with the Rule of Sequestration during the bond hearing.


